LDS WOMAN, EDUCATOR, DIES IN PROVO

Mrs. Emily Timothy Woodward, 65, prominent Utah educator and widow of Dr. Hugh M. Woodward, former Brigham Young University faculty member, died Saturday night in a Provo hospital of a heart ailment.

Mrs. Woodward was born Dec. 15, 1882, in Wallsburg, Wasatch county, a daughter of David and Martha Haws Timothy. When a child she moved with her parents to the Uintah basin and received her early education in Vernal schools. After graduating from Vernal high school she attended BYU in Provo. She married Dr. Woodward Oct. 16, 1905, in the Salt Lake Temple, Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. She was graduated from BYU in 1909.

SERVED DIXIE COLLEGE

In 1911 the couple moved to St. George, where Mrs. Woodward became head of the domestic science department and her husband president of Dixie junior college. In 1917 they moved to Berkeley, Cal., for study at the University of California. In 1921 they returned to Provo and Dr. Woodward became a member of the BYU faculty.

In 1929 and 1930 the couple served as members of the faculty of the floating university which toured the world making a study of comparative religions. In 1937 they moved to San Francisco, where Mrs. Woodward was active at the San Francisco Teachers' college. Dr. Woodward died Aug. 11, 1940, in San Francisco, and in 1946 Mrs. Woodward returned to Provo to reside.

ACTIVE IN CHURCH

She has been an active member of the LDS church, serving as a Relief Society teacher and as secretary for the Utah LDS stake Primary board for many years.

Survivors include a son, William Woodward, Trona, Cal.; two daughters, Mrs. R. B. Jarrel, Humble, Texas; Mrs. V. C. Hodgkinson, Provo; five sisters, Mrs. Ben Smith and Mrs. Donald Schmutz, St. George; Mrs. A. T. Johnson and Mrs. J. Wilford Bastian, Vernal; Mrs. Marvin Perry, Rockville; two brothers, David J. Timothy, St. George; Rulon Timothy, Provo, and five grandchildren.
