63 1/2 West 47 stretched to a post thence N 24 E 22 1/2 stretched
to the place of beginning adjoining lands of said Lash and
Clark containing five and one half acres strict measure it
being a part of a tract of lands conveyed to said Isaac Lash
and wife by Martin Swickard and wife as appears by
conveyance dated the thirteenth day of April 1816 being
a part of a large tract of land patented by Daniel Swickard
as appears by patent dated the eighth day April 1788
and entered in Rolls Office in patent book N^o 12 page
243 and reference therunto being had will more fully appear
